Fiabci pioneered international real estate education by establishing the Certified International Property Specialist (CIPS) designation in the 1980s.

A quarter of a century later, FIABCI University introduced a two-tiered graduate program in international real estate excellence: The FIABCI Professional Designation - FIREC and the FIABCI Diploma - Dipl. FIABCI.

The Federation offers two international programs: the Professional Designation, FIREC, designed for active real estate practitioners and the FIABCI Diploma in International Real Estate, which is offered in cooperation with Partner Universities.

Recipients of the Designation and Diploma are entitled to use the following: the FIABCI International Real Estate Consultant Designation, FIREC and the FIABCI Diploma, Dipl. FIABCI.

Partner universities participate in the program whereby their students can gain an opportunity to be involved with The International Real Estate Federation as “Student Candidates” interested in learning about opportunities in international real estate while working toward a “FIABCI-Partner University” Degree.

Some of the courses sponsored and promoted by FIABCI are: “Global perspectives in Real Estate”, “Commercial Real Estate Worldwide I”, “Commercial Real Estate Worldwide II”, “The paradigm Win Win”, “Global application of highest and best use”, “National and international Real Estate Skills” and “International Real Estate”.

FIABCI SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION

A focus of FIABCI is to assign scholarships to students who demonstrate a special interest in the field of international real estate.

The foundation that manages the program scholarships may provide coverage for travel expenses, rewards, gifts and funds to support its programmes, in the belief that the training of future leaders of the real estate industry is also a way to return to society part of the benefits that members get from the course of its activity: entrepreneurs are those who take risks, and FIABCI helps manage such risk.
